A MESSENGER.....

What is Christmas? A certain prince called Didymus (twin), the heir to his father's throne was called upon by his king to visit the kingdom disguised as a beggar and learn the mind of the citizens of the kingdom, to see what they thought of the king and his rule. The purpose of the king was twofold; in that, he would find out what changes needed to be brought in the governing of his kingdom and it was also a perfect opportunity for the son to learn more about the kingdom as he (the son) would one day take the king's place.

The obedient son does as instructed and leaves the security of his father's palace and soon finds himself becoming a part of the reality he sees around him. In his search to understand the mind of the people, he, himself becomes a beggar and forgets his own identity. His reality becomes the poverty he lives in and finds himself sleeping in dark and dank places where foul odors and dark wet floors are comforting, and where this poor soul finds his rest. Forgetting all the comforts of his father's house and his own identity, his heritage, he settles down with his life. Until........

The father in his desire to see his son learn, experience and mature has allowed this passage of time, in which he has seen his son fall into the state of mind of a beggar. And when he see's that his son will not return until he (the son) is renewed in his mind and awakens from this nightmare that he has slept himself into, the father reaches out. Remember the plan....... That in the dispensation of the fullness of times He (Father God) might gather together in one all things in Christ (anointed one, the word of salvation, the prince of peace), both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; (the palace and the outermost parts of the kingdom) *even* in him. (YESHUA, GOD IS SALVATION).
