I go to my Father, and thereby become Him.
I and my Father are ONE.

Here, the me, that isn't, is the conscious mind of 'self', even though to that consciousness the me is real, or feels and seems real, the me cannot truly become real until it becomes the ME that is.

The baptism into His (Christ's), death, is the dying and the burial of 'the me', that isn't. The ME that is, is that resurrected person, that was with Him from the beginning of creation. Resurrection is not an event; resurrection is a person. Jesus said, "I am the resurrection". That ME has always been, and I have always been that ME, but I was 'tricked', through the eating of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, to become consciously aware of myself as a separate me, which is really a false consciousness of my Real Self.
