The Dark Room

'You shall know the truth and the truth shall set you free'

It's like this:

Imagine you find yourself sitting in a completely dark room. There is no light whatsover entering this room and therefore you are totally unable to perceive or be aware of anything about the room or anything in it. You then start to wonder how on earth this woman can see with such clarity and detail in the dark? You decide to humble yourself and ask her. "How can you see these things when the room is completely dark?" Her reply astonishes you, and you wonder if she is perhaps not a little mad when she replies, "oh, the room is not dark. The room is full of light. The sunlight is streaming through the windows and everything can be clearly seen".

You think to yourself, "this can't be true, for I am aware of how dark the room is, and besides that, the man sitting at my right agrees with me. He too knows he is sitting in the same darkened room. So, how can she say, the room is full of light?"

You turn to her again and ask her. "If the room is full of light, then why can I not see the room and all its contents. I can only see darkness. I cannot see a thing. Nothing. I am not aware of any of the things you have mentioned. "Nor will you be", she replies. "As long as you continue to say, I am in a dark room. I cannot see a thing. I can only see the darkness, and as long as you continue to say these words, so shall the darkness remain with you. But rather you must speak

the truth". "But what is the truth", you ask. "I have already told you the truth", she replies, "the room is full of light. That *is* the truth". She continues by asking you a question., "look. You feel this is a very fair question, but again the woman's reply astonishes you. "There is no switch", she declares. "No one seeks a switch in a light room. You would only seek a switch in a dark room. Therefore by asking where is the switch? You merely compound your belief that you are in a dark room and not a light one, and thereby continue in the lie. Do you not see that?" "I do. I do". you reply. You are beginning to grasp what she means. You then say "correct me if I'm wrong, but what you are asking me to do is to simply accept the real truth about the room, that it is actually full of light, in spite of any appearances of darkness". "Yes, exactly, that is it", she affirms. "continue to state what is real and true, and your word will not return to you void. You will see the results of your faith, and you will then see the room as it truly is and has always been, for remember; you are not speaking the words to make a dark room light, but rather you are speaking the truth, that the room is, and has always been full of light.
