## Which Father Would You Rather Serve?

Mat 23:9 And call no [man] your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.

Mat 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

So. The will of the Father must first be done in heaven, before it can be done on the earth.

We know where heaven is, Jesus told us where it is. It is within us. He also says, in Mat 16:19 "And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shall be loosed in heaven".

This really means that whatsoever you bind on earth will be so, because it has already been bound in heaven, or what you loose on earth will be loosed, because it was first loosed in heaven. This is because the Father's will is done in heaven. A bit like a projector and screen. What ever image you have on the slide in the projector (consciousness, heaven), will be portrayed on the screen (appearance realm, earth). It is a total waste of time trying to improve or change the screen (the earth), as man has been trying to do for eons. No if you would see a change on earth, then go within and do your binding and loosing. Get the slide right and the screen must follow suit.

When Jesus taught the people how to pray, he started with the line, "Our Father which art in heaven" Right there, he qualifies which father we are to address. The one in heaven. He is talking to the masses here. Their Father? Wait a minute, they haven't been into a temple, or a church and asked Jesus in to their heart. They haven't received him, as taught by religion, but that didn't seem to bother Jesus - "Our Father". To use the word 'our' means he is saying that his Father is our Father. Call no man father. Yet we do. I always thought that my father was the guy who birthed me with my mother, yet here I find he was not my father. He was, but not my real father, I thought he was, because like most people I thought I was just a human being; but it turns out my Heavenly Father is my real father and he births spirit beings, so therefore I must be a spirit being and not just a mere human, as I have been led to believe all these years.

Anyway, to continue, Jesus then says, "Hallowed be thy name" Sacred, Holy is thy nature, personhood. The Father, is the only sacred, holy one. That's why Jesus says, for the Power is yours (and yours alone), and the Glory is yours (and yours alone).

"Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven". Here we see again the projector slide and the screen. The binding and loosing on the earth will be the Father's will, because it has been already done in heaven.

Let's look at some characters here, and see what they bound and loosed on earth. Look at the characters in this short list. Pharaoh, Moses, Pilate, Jesus, Judas, Paul. It is obvious from the list that they fall in to two camps. Pharaoh, Pilate, Judas. On the one side, and then Moses, Jesus and Paul on the other. Of course this list could be huge on both sides, but it's easier for you to read the bible than me make a complete list. What is the difference? they are all binding and loosing in heaven, but what a difference in the outcome on earth from the two camps. The interesting thing to notice here, is that they are ALL doing God's will. Hmm, I can here some people saying, not too sure about that.

Then let me ask you this. If Judas, or Pilate, had not have done what they did, we would not be celebrating the coming of our Saviour this Christmas, or any other for that matter. Look what Jesus said to Pilate, when Pilate said to him, "Don't you recognise the authority in me? I have the power, (side note - I thought God's was the Power), to set you free or to have you crucified. Jesus answered, "Thou couldest have no power [at all] against me, except it were given thee from above: Jhn 19:11. We need to note here that the words 'from above' are not referring to height as in the clouds are above my head, but rather above here means, a higher level, like the math of a sixteen year old will be higher (or above), that of a 5 year old.

Oh Pilate had power alright, but it WAS God's very own power. Same as Pharaoh. He had power alright, but it was still God's power that he was misusing.

Judas had power, but who's power was it? Please do not say the Devil. The devil has no power of his own. He is like a roaring lion, he isn't *actually* one. 1Pe 5:8 "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour": As a; otherwise it would just say 'a' roaring lion.

There is only One Power, as Jesus has already said, "For thine is the Power". The power not one of the powers, but the one and only power. The same could be said for 'The Glory', yet how man loves to glorify man, and in doing so steals God's very own Glory for themselves. Not all men of course, some do firmly place the credit where it is due. Jesus certainly did.

Exd 10:1 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go in unto Pharaoh: for I have hardened his heart, and the heart of his servants, that I might shew these my signs before him:

Rom 9:17 For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.

So what's going on here. We know Jesus came delighting in his Father's will, yet it is obvious that Pharaoh, Pilate and Judas, are also doing what God means to be happening. Not sure they were delighting though, think it was more like hard work, trying to achieve their own will.

One more for good measure. Here's what Joseph had to say to his brothers all those years later, "But as for you, ye thought evil against me; [but] God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as [it is] this day, to save much people alive. Gen 50:20. I find it interesting that it says, "you thought evil against me", and not you did evil against me, though they did that too when they put him in the pit. But it says 'thought', actions are the results of thoughts, that's why we have to have the right mind set if our actions are to be a result of the Christ mind, which we are told to 'let' it be in us.

So God meant it. He didn't allow it, He didn't cause it, but He did mean it.

So, if all the characters in the list are doing the will of God. What is the difference. What is the difference in their work, business, acts, words, opposed to Moses Jesus and Paul?

Burning Bush time: Had Moses not seen the burning bush I'm sure that things would have been different, but he did see it, and it spoke huge revelation, awakening and recognition to his inner man. Went right into his heaven, where the angels, (his thoughts) revealed to him what this bush stood for. In that plain and simple, probably a bit 'tatty' bush, burned a fire that did not consume the bush. Deu 4:24 For the LORD thy God [is] a consuming fire. God is the fire. I'm sure that Moses saw he was the bush, at that point, but the most important thing is that he recognised how (the fire), God, could live within the bush, (Moses), without the bush (Moses),

getting burned. Jesus said, "I and my Father are ONE". He did not even relate to himself on the 'bush level', his whole awareness and consciousness, was of him and the fire working together as ONE. Moses may well of said this himself, "Oh my goodness, I see who I really am". I don't know if he did.

Paul said, "It is not me living here it is Christ living here, it is the Father working through his Son, and that's who I am". Gal 2:20

So there is the difference. The difference between heaven and hell. The difference between the eyes set on the flesh (I'm just me, or I'm a me in my own right), or I and My Father are ONE, of myself I can do nothing. I have not come to glorify myself, but to glorify my Father who is not only my life, but he is also your life, in fact the only life and power there is in the whole universe.

Wow, what a different mind set compared to Phoaroh's, Judas' and Pilate's mind sets. They had to work with what they had, and what they had was just themselves, or so they wrongly believed. But even so, it was God's power they were using, or rather mis-using. But then, let's be fair here we've all done that.

There is only one electricity, there is not two different types of electricity. A good one that makes life more comfortable for us, with heating, light, music, dvd's and tv's etc, then a bad one that blows fuses causes fires and kills through electric shock. No, it is the same electricity. An electrician has a huge respect for electricity, and he knows how to correctly use it. The layman has no true real respect, and wonders why his equipment keeps blowing fuses or catching fire, or even throwing him across the room, because he got the wires crossed. Did electricity mean to shock him when he grasped the live wire? Of course it did, that's how electricity works. Did electricity cause it? No the guy caused it, by getting his wires crossed. That's all the problem is. We have our wires crossed. We are creating hell in our heaven loosing it on earth, and working with the screen to try and put it all right again.

Right at the beginning, God said - "It is good, in fact it is very good". So why are we trying to improve it. STOP. "Be Still and Know that I AM God. I AM the Power, and the Glory is mine, and I will share my Glory with no man, but always with my Son.

I will share it with you, when you are ready, when you can receive it. When you have the integrity to have it. When YOU like my Moses recognise who YOU really are then you will be able to say the same as Jesus said, " And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was". Jhn 17:5
