

ANSWER TO A FRIENDS LETTER CONCERNING WALTER LANYON QUOTES

He that has ears shall hear what the Scripture says unto the Churches, and only he that has a single eye is through with trying to twist meanings to suit personal ends. **But he that has the consciousness of the Son of the Living God shall not find it strange that "he that is of too pure eyes to behold iniquity" should laugh at the belief in it that has bound men for so long;**

It has come to my understanding that as man we straddle two realities. Many are now saying that each of us is a multidimensional personality. This is true.
