

1st state - Sunday-

Illumination.

And God said, "let there be light" and there was light, and God separated the light from the darkness.

In the regenerative purposes of God, this is the first state of man. Man receives the illuminative knowledge of God. Man becomes aware and has a consciousness of the divine.

And this is the entrance of the divine life of God into the being of man but man does not yet know that this is his life.

2nd state - Monday -

Devotion.

And God said, " let there be a firmament between the waters and let it divide the waters from the waters".

Man now has received a consciousness of the divine and begins a search for the divine. Now comes the separation between the waters which signify the letter of the word or the external appearance and the waters which signify the Spirit of life in the word. Here we find that one who is now aware or conscious of the Creator, begins to live from the lower waters or the waters under the firmament. The firmament is called the heavens and touches the waters under and the waters above, signifying that though the external appearance of truth is separated from the internal Spirit of life, yet the one who is in the lower state is able to enter into the higher state.

3rd state-Tuesday - Transformation.

Now comes the gathering of the waters under the firmament and the appearance of dry land.

Now this one begins to be convicted by the external letter of truth, this is called the gathering of the waters of the seas and the result of those convictions causes man to take a stance or stand upon a foundation, this foundation is called the land appearing which is also the earth that that person is become.

Here we find something else also happens, the birth or manifestation of degrees of thoughts begin to sprout from the earth. These thoughts or convictions are an outward formation or expression of inward convictions. They manifest first as grass. Grass is not deep rooted and much like one whose ideas which first reveal themselves but are not from experience but simply head knowledge.

Then comes the herb yielding seed which is the head knowledge beginning to mix with experience as one grows more mature in their convictions and finally, the tree yielding fruit whose seed is in itself, which signifies maturity and reproducing or multiplication for the fruit is the final expression of the seed and also has the seed to bring forth more of the same.

4th state -Wednesday - Manifestation.

And God made two lights in the heavens, the greater light to rule the day and the lesser light to rule the night.

Now we see the manifestation of faith in the will, the sun and in the understanding, the moon. The sun being the direct source of light and the moon being the reflector of the sun's light. When the sun gives its light spiritually, we find that we are able to live by faith in our will to do and when the moon gives its light, though we have not the will yet, we do have some faith by which we understand. The sun gives us seasons, while the moon gives us signs. The truths of God first come to our understanding but it is not until they come to our will that we act upon them, hence signs seasons and days or states and years, or completion of one state to move to another.

5th state- Thursday - Fruition.

In this state the moment of expectation is past and the season of fruition is come. Every aspect of man's being begins to bear fruit and that is what the creatures or living things signify.

Fowl or birds that fly above in the heavens are those thoughts in our mind that carry heavenly ideas and raise up our spirit to be one with His Spirit. And those whales and living creatures that move in the waters are fruitful emotions that bring harmony.

Remember the whale that swallowed and spat out Jonah at Nineveh. Therefore it signifies repentance and renewing of God's word in our emotions.

6th state- Friday - Creation.

Now the earth brings forth the living creature. Remember that the earth signifies the foundation that one stands upon. What foundation is one building upon? Is it wood, hay and stubble, or precious stones, gold and silver?

The living creature that the earth brings forth is categorized into that which produces the milk of the word, namely cattle, then that which brings forth cunning thoughts, namely creeping, and that which brings forth other creatures that characterize us.

Man dwells in three realms as he is made up of these three realms : heavens, earth and seas.

More of this is explained in the revelation of Jesus Christ.

Once the earth brings forth all that God says is good, man is made in the image and likeness of God.

7th - Saturday - Cessation.

And God's work is completed as man is now MADE in His image, according to His likeness. And God rests from all His work of regeneration.
