

Exodus 12:1

[1]And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying,

12:1 (internal sense)

To the church:

And the Lord has spoken to you, when He drew you (Moses) out of your natural and old adam and spoke His Word(Aaron) to you. He called you out and separated you out of this world.

And this is the new understanding and new willingness He has given to you.

Exodus 12:2

[2]This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.

Ex 12:2 ( internal sense)

This state shall be the beginning of your new states. This state shall be the first entrance into the perfect Kingdom.

Exodus 12:3

[3]Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:

Ex 12:3 (internal sense)

Share this with the body of Christ from generation to generation until everyone begins to lay hold of the lamb(innocence ).

Exodus 12:4

[4]And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbour next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb.

Ex 12:4 (internal sense)

There must be true fellowship between the brethren, so much so that each may not lack, because his neighbour is able to supply his need, until all have that which is in their ability to understand and lay hold of.

Exodus 12:5

[5]Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats:

Ex 12:5 (internal sense)

The nature your now putting on is the lamb nature and is new. Not like the spotted and blemished with sin nature you had before. This nature shall be without spot or blemish. The first state of truth, however it can be an external truth, which comes from the understanding or an internal truth, which comes from the will.

Exodus 12:6

[6]And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.

Ex 12:6 (internal sense)

And you must treasure this truth, till it begins to fill your being and when this condition becomes a state of being, then shall you begin to lay hold of.

Exodus 12:7

[7]And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it.

Ex 12:7 (internal sense)

Remember the life of the Lamb, remember to hold it close to your heart and your mind and then you shall begin to appropriate it.

Exodus 12:8

[8]And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; and with bitter herbs they shall eat it.

Ex 12:8 (internal sense)

The church shall receive this lamb nature in the understanding and then the will. And this is how the church will begin the appropriation if this nature. The church begins by receiving the Word of Christ, a word that is refined, tested and pure, without mixture, a word that separates soul from Spirit.

Exodus 12:9

[9]Eat not of it raw, nor sodden at all with water, but roast with fire; his head with his legs, and with the purtenance thereof.

Ex 12:9 (internal sense)

We must continuously test the maturity of this Word within us and constantly examine ourselves, whether we walk in the faith. There must be uncompromising belief and it must not be for pleasing ourselves or others, but tested and refined.

Let this nature be perfected in our mind and transform our walk, so that Christ be formed in us completely.

Exodus 12:10

[10]And ye shall let nothing of it remain until the morning; and that which remaineth of it until the morning ye shall burn with fire.

Ex12:10(internal sense)

You are entering into a new day, therefore be ye consumed with the zeal of the Lord.

Exodus 12:11

And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the LORD'S passover.

Ex 12:11(internal sense)

Therefore be ready, gird up your loins with truth, put on the shoes of the gospel, and take the Power of God in your hands, the sword of the Spirit and be not slow of understanding. It is the LORD'S new day.

Exodus 12:12

[12]For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.

Ex 12:12(internal sense)

Let me tell you why it's the LORD'S new day?

This is what the Lord is going to do. He says He will write His law in our hearts, that we may come from darkness to light, knowing that God is destroying every pre-eminent thought and affection of the world in us, whether it be passive or aggressive, even against every god that we have created while in the world.

For He is the Lord.

Exodus 12:13

[13]And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.

Ex 12:13(internal sense)

Be not afraid children, for you have been given the life of my beloved Son and this life shall always be your covering, so that nothing unclean will overtake you. Though you are in the world, you are not of the world.

Exodus 12:14

[14]And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a feast to the LORD throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever.

Ex 12:14(internal sense)

Remember to always be mindful of this new state. Let the whole church celebrate the Lord with every remembrance. Make this a regular habit that you may never forget. This is what the Lord says, whereto you have already attained, walk by the same rule, mind the same thing.

Exodus 12:15

[15]Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.

Ex 12:15(internal sense)

And this is how you are to perfect this new state. Eat and appropriate the Word in holiness, cleave to that which is good and hate evil. This must be a priority, for this is a beginning in the Kingdom for you, therefore nothing of evil must enter or touch you, for if it does, it will surely take you back into the world and away from this state of righteousness.

Exodus 12:16

[16]And in the first day there shall be an holy convocation, and in the seventh day there shall be an holy convocation to you; no manner of work shall be done in them, save that which every man must eat, that only may be done of you.

Ex 12:16(internal sense)

Gather your thoughts and affections towards the Lord, let this be your first and perfect work. Remember, it is to be done by the Spirit and not by the flesh.

Exodus 12:17

[17]And ye shall observe the feast of unleavened bread; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever.

Ex 12:17(internal sense)

Once again, I cannot emphasize how important it is that you observe, that is, keep your eyes (perception) on the reason for the celebration and how you are to celebrate it, for in this new state, I have made you whole and separated you from the world, therefore this state is to be made perfect, unchanging and complete.
