THE DOMINION AND THE BIRTHRIGHT

Ever since Eve ate up the lies of the serpent and brought forth the fruit thereof, man has believed that he is the god of this world. And so it is that the fallen man of earth has taken dominion over this planet and this world. Powerful individuals have arisen to establish their dominion over territories and peoples.

Through this earthly man, the mind of the serpent is ruling the world. This mandate had been given to the Christ man in God's image. The fallen man of earth has usurped the place of Christ and has made himself the god of this world. The struggle for dominion and the birthright has been at work ever since.

Dominion has to do with ruling and reigning. The dominion given to the Son is the throne of God's kingdom in earth as it is in heaven. *"But unto the Son he (God) saith, "Thy throne O God, is for ever and ever: a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of thy kingdom."* (Heb.1: 8b)

God the Father has delegated the affairs of the earth to His Son. God's kingdom or rule is in Spirit (in heaven) while the Son is subduing the earth (man of earth). This is why Jesus taught us to pray, *"Thy kingdom come, thy will be done in earth as it is in heaven."* The Son is the true heir of God the Father.

The first son when mature is heir of all that His Father is and has. To better understand this, let us take another look at the creation of man. When God (Elohim) created this little blue planet, He did it this

with "man" in mind. During eons of time, God created many forms of life in the earth, but when those ages were fulfilled, He began the creation of a man of the earth that would be reborn into His image and likeness. God who is spirit desires to be expressed in a physical earthly body. The man that God had in mind was the Christ creation man.

Therefore, on the sixth day, God created a man after His own image and likeness. The only way the characteristics of a man can be passed on to another individuals is through a birth. Only a son bears the express image of his father.

The only one who can bear the likeness and perfect image of God is the Son of God. We saw Him when He was made flesh. We read that Son *"Who being the brightness of his glory, and the EXPRESS IMAGE OF HIS PERSON and upholding all things by the word of his power.."* (Heb.1: 3a)

Jesus in the flesh was the express image of the person of God. He is also the Man who was given dominion over the earth and the birthright as heir of God *"..being appointed heir of all things."* (Vs.2a) In the Law, the first Son receives the birthright. The birthright is the inheritance of ALL that the Father possesses including his name.

The Man that Elohim created on the sixth day was the image and likeness of Father God. He was given DOMINION over the creation of God and He was appointed heir of all things; this man was truly the Son of God. Beginning with Cain and Abel, the Son's position for dominion began a deadly struggle within man and between men.

THE MAN OF DUST APPEARS

God had prepared the planet and all the environment for the man of the earth. He had specifically and carefully made the atmosphere with a perfect mixture of all the elements needed for man to breathe. He ordained laws such as the law of gravity that keeps man anchored to the mass of the earth and not floating in space.

God also gave provisions for the needs of this man. *“And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing SEED, which is upon the face of the earth, and every tree...”*(Gen. 1:29)

All things pertaining to life were perfectly set in place for the earthly man. Man would not need to live in a bubble or in a space suit; man could enjoy the beauty of the earth, breathe in the clean air and experience joy and satisfaction among the flora and fauna freely and without fear. God's beautiful creation was totally prepared to welcome and to support the life of the man of earth.

We know that God had given **His image and likeness** and the dominion to the Man that He brought forth on the sixth day. He also commanded that man to replenish and SUBDUE the earth. This was a command, a mandate with God's authority. The man of earth would have to be subdued by the man of the Spirit.

God spoke these words to the man in His image and likeness, *“And God (Elohim) blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful and multiply, and replenish the earth, and **subdue it: and have dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over **every living thing that moveth upon the earth.**”* (Gen.1: 28) God's purpose was to send this man of Spirit into the earth.

“And God (Elohim) saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.” (Vs.31) Then on the seventh day God rested yet the earth was not replenished in His image and likeness and it was not subdued. When the man in God's image came to the earth there was not a man of earth

that could even plow and cultivate the ground. In order for God's man to be fruitful and multiply and to SUBDUE the earth, he had to form a body from the dust. Then he would have to bring this “body” unto subjection to the Spirit of God. This opened the door to the battle of the ages.

We read, *“And the Lord God, (Jehovah-Elohim) formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and man became a living soul.”* (Gen.2: 7) This was the first order of business for the One who had been given dominion over the earth..the One now called the “Lord God.”

The man of spirit needed a man of earth in whom to plant His seed and multiply His image as God had commanded. He formed the man that He needed out of the dust and now this man needed Him for His very life. To accomplish the plan of God, they needed each other.

Elohim had rested on the sixth day when Jehovah-Elohim (the Son) *“Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of EVERY CREATURE.”* (Col.1: 15) began His work in the earth on the seventh day of creation. He took a lump of dust and formed a man that He called “earthy” or “Red” like the earth or like the blood that was coursing in his veins. This earthy man was Adam.

The Lord God breathed His life into this man of earth and the man became a “living soul.” Soul and body are one. The soul is the spirit part of man and it is sustained by the Spirit.

The man of earth needs this Man of the Spirit (Christ) for life; and the Christ man needs the earthy man to multiply Himself in the earth. The Man after God's own image and the man of the earth need each other to fulfill God's perfect plan in the earth.

After The Lord God formed his man out of the dust, He took the seeds that Elohim had given him and He began planting them in the earth. *“And out of the ground made the Lord God to grow every tree...”* (Vs.9) We must see that both in the literal dirt of the earth and in the man of earth, seeds were being planted. The seeds of God's image were being

planted in the man of earth. The great Sower was at work in the field to bring the fruit of the Spirit in this man of earth. This was also the beginning of trouble because not long after that, the man of earth (the woman) held the conversation with the serpent.

The man after God's own image is the Christ man who has been given dominion and who came down to the earth to fulfill God's mandate. He is the Author and the Finisher, the Alpha and Omega, the Beginning of the creation of God. He was never deceived; it was the woman who was deceived.

The man of dust is the first who is seen in the earth. The Spirit remains invisible. The earthly man is designed to become the image of the Christ man. *"And so it is written, the first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit."* (I Cor.15: 45)

Both men began the journey that will transform the dusty man into the Christ man. (*Christ formed in you*). The Christ man has to subdue this Dusty man who is deceived and believes he has the dominion.

Our carnal minds are not able to understand the things of Spirit for they are at spiritually discerned. *"But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto OUR glory."* (I Cor. 2: 7)

The first visible man is the Adam earthly man. He is the first body and soul creature with a womb to nurture the seed of life that will someday transform the earthy man into the man from heaven. Paul wrote, *"And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly."* (I Cor.15: 49)

But Paul did not leave it there. He insisted that this is not given unto corruptible flesh and blood therefore *"Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed."* (Vs.51) This change has been working in the hearts of His called out people for centuries, howbeit, it has not been seen externally. While the inner man has been changing, the outer man has remained the same.

We are informed that the complete change will be seen SUDDENLY and the finished work will be manifested, *"In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed."* (I Cor. 15: 52)

Paul prayed that we might understand what is the *"riches of his inheritance in the saints."* The saints become His dwelling place in the earth when they receive their inheritance in Him. *"The Spirit beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: and if children, then heirs; heirs of God and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together."* (Rom.8: 16-17)

As children, we have to mature in Christ and be tested in the school of life to receive the inheritance. And the inheritance is the BIRTHRIGHT which is Christ and eternal life. We have been given "the EARNEST OF OUR INHERITANCE" when we were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise. *"Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory."* (Eph.1: 14)

Jesus has purchased and redeemed us by His sacrifice on the cross, but now He is redeeming that which He has already paid for. He is doing this by His Holy Spirit as the Spirit redeems the property that belongs to Him- our spirit, soul and body. *"And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."* (I Thes.5: 23)

This is reaped when the Man after God's image in us has fully subdued this earthy man. *"Lie not to one another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; and have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him.."* (Col. 3: 9-10)

This is the battle for dominion. The old man of earth has put on the mind of the serpent when he believed his lie. The serpent could then rule the world as the "prince of the power of the air." He then became the god of this world. *"Wherein in time past*

ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air; the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience.” (Eph.2: 2)

When man believes that by his own intellect (knowledge), he rules the world, he kills the man of Spirit within and gives the place that belongs to Christ over to the serpent. The battle for dominion has been raging within each man that comes into the world ever since. Yet this is God's plan.

THE FIRST DOMINION STRUGGLE THE DEATH OF ABEL

The Old Testament is chock full of examples of this fight for the birthright and the dominion. Although the characters of the Old Testament actually lived their lives, they are written for us as examples and parallels of our spiritual journey in Christ.

Paul wrote, *“I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.” (Phil.3: 14)* The prize is Christ. *“...and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ.” (Vs.8)*

Christ is the eternal life within. He is the new man that is being formed in the earthen vessel. He is the prize of this calling. He is the One who will totally reclaim dominion over creation and possess this vessel to present it to God the Father that He might be all in all.

The very first example of this struggle for the prize is clearly seen in Cain and Abel. Cain was the first born and should have been the heir of the birthright but his offering was not acceptable to the Lord. Why did it happen that way? God's ways are not our ways. This is a little difficult to grasp but it has to do with the deception. Earthy Adam is the first man to appear in the world and so he counts himself as the heir but in God's economy the first man is the Christ man and He is heir of all things.

The man who is heir is the second Man to appear

in the earth and who actually was before Adam. God saw the nature of the first Man in Abel's sacrifice. Abel was the true heir of God for He had His nature.

The Pharisees made the same error. They thought that Jesus' first appearance was when He was born of Mary in Bethlehem. But Jesus told them, *“Verily, verily, I say unto you, before Abraham was, I am.” (Jn.8: 58)* This is why throughout the Old Testament we see that the inheritance or the birthright is given to the second or the youngest son.

God tested the first two sons. Cain, the first one produced beautiful earthly fruits which he offered as sacrifice. He was the earthy man and could produce much from the earth.

But Abel who is the second born, pleased God with his blood sacrifice of a lamb. The life of the flesh is in the blood. No one can produce a lamb out of the earth; life is a gift of God. Abel's sacrifice represents the living Christ sacrifice. It was the Christ nature in Abel that riled the jealous serpent nature of earthy Cain.

Cain had taken on the nature of the serpent which is at enmity or totally opposite and hostile to Christ. Driven by that nature, Cain rose up with great fury against his brother and slew him. Abel's blood is still crying from the ground along with all those who were slain as heirs of God and of Christ since. The nature of the Christ has not yet prevailed in the world. And this is God's perfect plan.

From that day forward, the earthy man had the upper hand in this world. Every child who followed after the Christ nature was headed for the same struggle and the same death as Abel. The Man of the Spirit has been rejected, bruised and slain by the powers of the prince of this world that rules the earthy man Adam.

This became obvious when Jesus was born in flesh and blood. The religious serpent who had fathered the minds of the rulers ..Jesus told the Pharisees, *“Ye are of your father the devil..”* so they rose up in all their fury and set out snares for Him until they finally crucified Him.

THE PERSECUTION OF CHRIST IN JOSEPH

Jesus had prophesied about this in a parable. “A certain householder planted a vineyard and let it out to husbandmen while he went to a far country. When harvest time came, he sent his servants that they might receive the fruits of it. But the husbandmen took his servants and beat one and killed another.

He repeated this and again they killed his servants.” *“But last of all he sent unto them his son, saying, They will reverence my son. But when the husbandmen saw the son, they said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and let us seize on his inheritance. And they caught him, and cast him out of the vineyard, and slew him.”* (Matt. 21: 37-39)

This prophecy came to pass many times as those who served the Lord have been persecuted and rejected. When those who are filled with the spirit of this world sense the nature of the Son, their fury and animosity cannot be appeased and they set out to kill Him without mercy.

This can be seen in the earth today as the religious powers of this world are out to kill everyone who names the name of Christ and of Jehovah. Today, one of those religious beasts has arisen out of the sea of humanity and its fury is fueled by such animosity and malice that it cannot be stopped.

They are determined to bring to extinction all who name the name of Christ and of Jehovah. We are seeing much of this today as the peace of earth is being turned into a veritable hell.

The serpent nature in the earthy man has taken over the place that belongs to Christ. This is why they killed the prophets of old. They killed the Son of God and every son since. **YET THIS IS THE PLAN OF GOD. FOR WITHOUT DEATH THERE COULD BE NO RESURRECTION.**

This is all about the body that shall be for the Seed of the Son of God has been sown in earthen vessels that are about to be raised by the mighty power of the Christ formed within over the hell and death of this world.

Who among us does not love the story of young Joseph? From an early age Joseph had a huge problem; he was the beloved son of his father AND God spoke to him through vivid dreams. All who hear from the Lord in dreams know that although they are a great blessing, they are often the quickest way to die among brethren.

We may quickly conclude that Joseph did not use much wisdom when he revealed his dreams to his brothers; but it was all in God's plan. He must have been eager to tell them when he met them in the fields and said, *“For behold, we were binding sheaves in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and also stood upright; and, behold, your sheaves stood round about, and made obeisance to my sheaf.”* (Gen.37: 7)

The brothers caught the drift right away. Joseph was called to be a ruler over them!! But that was not the end of the matter. *“And he dreamed yet another dream, and told it to his brethren, and said, Behold, I have dreamed a dream more; and, behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me.”* (Vs. 9)

Joseph had sealed his fate with them. They were threatened and irked. They could not let that go on. This pipsqueak could not ever rule over them and receive the birthright and dominion that belonged to them. Yet this is what his dreams meant.

We know the rest of the story. They proceeded right then and there with their evil plan to kill him. Only they really could not kill him so they sold him to a caravan of Ishmaelites who later sold him to Potiphar the Egyptian.

Joseph was as good as dead to his family and to anything that would have been his in his father's house. Joseph lost his identity and became as an Egyptian. However, his true identity had yet to be revealed. This would come after years of much suffering.

It was more than jealousy that drove the brothers to kill this young man; it was the enmity between the serpent and the woman. It was the consuming hatred in the heart of the flesh man lusting for the dominion and the birthright. And yet it was all ordained of God. Joseph who is a type of Christ in His Body had to suffer and be slain in order to be raised again to new life and to **save much life**.

This is why when he finally revealed himself to his brethren he could declare, *“Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life.”* (Gen.45: 5)

And again, *“But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass as it is this day, to save much people alive.”* (Gen.50: 20) This is the plan of God for Christ in His creation and it is God's plan for us in Christ.

OUR OLD MAN IS CRUCIFIED with Christ

In the sixth verse of the sixth chapter of the sixth book of the New Testament we read, *“Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.”* (Rom.6: 6)

The cross of Jesus is our victory over sin and the body of sin. This is why Paul writes, *“I beseech you therefore brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.”* (Rom.12: 1)

God's Holy Spirit has been patiently bringing our entire being unto submission to Himself. This is our living sacrifice. This is basically what Paul was saying. When my spirit was awakened to the reality of His presence within, I became converted and began to do the things He led me to do. I first followed the path of Christians in the world and began to go to church on Sunday. Then I read my Bible and carried it with me every day. These were new things my body yielded itself to doing. I was being totally subdued by the Spirit.

There were also things I quit doing. I quit smoking and began to take authority by the Spirit over my behavior. As I went on with the Lord, I received significant dreams and understanding of them. I did not follow the dreams but the dreams showed me what God was doing in my life. All this was from the Spirit but when I shared the dream with my Pastor at the time, my husband and I both were **boldly** rejected from that church.

I was thirty years old at the time, yet I became a babe in the Spirit and then grew to be a “spiritual teenager.” By that time I was attending church with a group of people who also had been rejected from their churches because of their Word. Things were moving fast and our lives were changing.

Then the Lord set me up behind a pulpit to preach the Word He spoke to me. In dreams, the Lord showed me graphically the corruption that is in the churches and even in the group that I was attending. Yet I continue to preach what I had been shown in the dreams. This continued until the leaders finally used their powers to squeeze me out of their company. However, the zeal of a spiritual teenager did not produce the will of God. I had to die.

Then I had the dream about the huge rattle snake. *“In the dream I was outside the gate of my backyard. There was a large grassy area with trees and foliage and as I look I saw on the opposite edge of that area a very large rattle snake all coiled up with his rattlers up in the air. He was lethal and menacing. In the dream, I knew that this was the serpent of Old.*

Then I see a young boy in the area. He was beautiful with the deepest blue eyes and blue hair to match his eyes. He looked innocent and I wanted to warn him about the snake but before I knew it, the rattler had pierced him with his powerful fangs. The boy was then laying on his side trying to raise up but I called to him and told him to lie very still and that would give him a little more time before the venom saturated his whole being.” (End of dream)

At the time I could not possibly understand this dream but I knew it was a word from the Lord. It

was later, after it came to pass and I had recovered from being rejected for the Word that it became clearer. The young blue-eyed blue-haired boy was the Word that the Lord had given me. The rattler was the “religious system” that was out to kill that Word. It was my death among them and it was God.

It was because of the dreams that revealed the carnal and dangerous devices of the group's leader that I was labeled “deceived” and rejected. It was then that I realized that the rattler had injected its venom to stop the word from ever being spoken again by me. This was repeated several times over the years as the Lord sent me and my husband for seasons among other such assemblies.

I am so grateful to the Lord for taking me out quickly. I died the death with Jesus (the Word). He did not leave me to die in bondage. He made His Word so real that I could never turn away from it.

I have said all this to show that every time the serpent attacks the Word you speak, in whatever form that serpent presents himself, he is crucifying the Christ anew. And when Christ in us is crucified, we die the same death as well.

Paul wrote that *“We are crucified with Christ.”* Indeed we were with Him on the cross of Calvary but beloved, we are with Him every time He is crucified anew for the Word He has given us to speak. The death that He dies, we die with Him and so when He will appear, we will appear with Him in glory. *“When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.”* (Col. 3: 4) This is how our old man is crucified with Christ.

JACOB HAVE I LOVED

When the apostle Paul explained the difference between the children of the flesh and the children of the promise, he made this startling declaration, *“As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated.”* (Rom.9: 13)

God said to the prophet Malachi, *“I loved Jacob, and I hated Esau, and laid his mountains and his heritage waste for the dragons of the wilderness.”* (Mal. 1: 2b-3)

The difference between the two is as day and night yet they are twin brothers. Both Jacob and Esau issue from Isaac and Rebekah who are both chosen of God. This is a graphic teaching for us as it clearly depicts the process that has been taking place in each and every man that is born in Adam.

God loved Jacob and He chose Jacob and He hated Esau. *“What shall we say then? Is there unrighteousness with God? God forbid. For he saith to Moses, I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion. So then it is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that showed mercy.”* (Rom.9: 14-16)

Paul continues to explain that God raised Pharaoh, to show forth His glory in the earth, *“...For this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.”* (Vs.17b)

It was the Lord who raised up Pharaoh with such a stubborn heart that he withstood the plagues until even his own firstborn son was dead. In this, God showed forth His power and glory as He took all of the children of Israel out of Egypt with a mighty high hand.

God had raised Pharaoh for this purpose and God has raised all the “Pharaohs” in the land ever since that in the end He may show forth His mighty power to save His creation. Yet John wrote that *“..the true Light, lighteth every man that cometh into the world.”* (Jn.1: 9)

God makes a way for all to see the true Light but they can only see when God opens their eyes. It was not time for the Pharisees in Jesus time. They had to execute God's plan and crucify the Lord of glory.

The life of Jacob is a parallel with our own walk and calling in God. We can glean many truths from it and find courage and hope for the journey. We can discover that the Esau man is not far remote from our old nature and that the two are very much engaged by the Lord to bring us to our full maturity and inheritance in Christ.

TWO KINDS OF PEOPLE

Jacob was not far behind Esau in time of birth. They already struggled in the womb and even his hand pushed forward to be the first one out. The Lord had prophesied to Rebekah his mother, *“Two nations are in thy womb, and two manner of people shall be separated from thy bowels; and the one people shall be stronger than the other people; and the elder shall serve the younger.”* (Gen.25: 23)

Just as Eve gave birth to two kinds of people: Cain and Abel. So Rebekah who is a type of the Church gave birth to two sons who were totally opposite in nature. We find these opposites in many of the Bible's characters so we know that there are two opposite natures in the world and within each man who is born in this world.

Jacob's name means “supplanter” and so Jacob lived up to his name. He has been accused of being a finagler and a schemer. As we read his life's story, it certainly appears to be so yet God who looks upon the heart declared, *“... I loved, but Esau have I hated.”*

Peter declared, *“Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons.* (Acts 10:34) That means that the outer countenance of a person or their position in life makes no difference to God; but He does care about the heart. God looks upon the heart. God said of David, *“I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfill all my will.”* (Acts 13: 22b)

David certainly was not perfect in the flesh and neither was Jacob. Both were “sinners” after the flesh. We know the story of David and Bathsheba and we read of Jacob's many schemes and manipulations. But on closer study of their lives we must conclude that both these men indeed had a heart for God.

Jesus declared, *“Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name he may give it to you.”* (Jn. 15: 16)

It was so for the first disciples and it is so with each disciple that He has chosen since. *“According as he hath chosen us in him, before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love.”* (Eph.1: 4)

Freedom of choice is not ours as some want to make us believe; freedom of choice belongs to God. We were not chosen haphazardly or at random, we were carefully chosen with purpose before the world was. God looks upon the heart. Just as He chose David knowing of his weaknesses in the flesh, He chose Jacob and not his twin brother Esau. In the same way, God ALWAYS CHOOSES THE JACOB IN US AND HATES THE ESAU!

Jacob was a “supplanter” even in his mother's womb. However Jacob was not motivated by a need of power and prestige above his brother; He was driven by a burning desire for the “birthright” which is the inheritance This is what motivates the Jacob in us.

When one is chosen for God's purpose such as Abel, Joseph, Jacob and the many more that followed, that one will suffer because of the Christ nature which is opposite to the nature of the man of dust. One would think that the Christ nature would win every time, but indeed it is the opposite. The Christ nature is called to lay down its life each time.

The reason for this is that without a death there is no resurrection. Christ who physically laid His life down on the cross also laid His life down in each of His called out ones. So that they die with Him and also rise with Him in newness of life.

Think not that this is all done vicariously and that we do not feel the death. This death is not an imagined participation; it is spiritual and it is the real thing. For some it is also physical. We are absolutely rejected of all men for our word and because our Word has molded our personality we are bodily rejected. We become misfit in ALL of man's religious systems. More later... Amen!
