I understand the logic in men such as Steiner that it's not good to share beyond ones experience, and all of us should live by what we understand to be the highest good for themselves and others. As for me personally to share only what I have experienced is for me to hold down what I believe to be true. I cannot live by this rule/concept. Chances are if I could sit down with Mr. Steiner over a cup of coffee, he and I may very well agree concerning his statement here in his letter to the lady friend. As for the face value of his comment I cannot agree.

This is primarily the reason I try to refrain from making concrete judgments on things I read that someone has written if I cannot agree with it. Words written are too easily misconstrued. As for me, I often share beyond my experience. If I were required to share nothing but things that I have experienced I would be extremely limited in what I could share. I share what I see with others regardless if it's been my experience on the physical plane or not which brings up this question in my mind.

Would not what I see in the spirit be an experience? And if not as some would tell me, why would I need to wait until it manifests on the physical plane before I share it? My answers to these questions may be different then someone else's. I feel that anything one share's that is positive must be true on some level. Much of what I share that I see today used to make my human mind go bonkers. I was assaulting the human mind {that devil that sat somewhere between my ears} and that was a good thing. I often, in my earlier years made deliberate assaults on my mind for the purpose of stretching it to accommodate the truth.

I would stand in my living room and make affirmations like "I am Alfa and Omega the first and the last, the beginning and the ending of all things." "I am the one and only power in all of creation and there are no other Gods before Me." etc. etc. "I am that which animates all creation on all levels of all that is." as I made theses statements I could almost feel my intellect being stretched. If I waited until all I see became my experience on the three dimensional plane I would soon become bored and take up bungee jumping. 😊

Our vision in the age is growing deeper by leaps and bounds. My feeling is when we share in faith what we see it becomes that much closer to manifesting on the physical. I see the two as closely related. The new earth is being created as we grow from duality into the one mind. What I see is what I get. So if I share what I see and others see it too as a result they also get what they see as well even though like me they may not see it now. This is why I believe in sharing what I see regardless of whether it has appeared in my life on the physical level or not.
