

LETTER TO A FRIEND

Regarding the anointing...

Your question was in regard to the anointing and what can stop it from ministering to someone who resists it. You said and I quote...

"you said if our anointing is rejected then it stops flowing and I'm wondering is it because they have caused it to stop or is it because we have sensed that it is not being received and we stop?"

My answer to your question is this... when anyone shares from the "anointing" they are sharing from the depths of their being. Another way to put this is that they are sharing from spirit. When I read where Paul wrote, "All they that are joined to the Lord are one spirit with him," this I receive as true, I take it as the word of truth.

To whatever degree my soul has been mingled with Spirit the anointing that I share with will be pure and without ego. Another way of saying it is this... to whatever degree I have experienced the brokenness that comes from the mistakes I've made and acknowledged, just to this degree will what I share be from the word of truth. I realize I've not answered your question yet but I'm coming to that.

It's just that there are times when I feel that a question requires more than

just a yes or no answer. The answer to your question is that both are correct. They have caused it to stop due to spirit sensing that what I'm sharing is not being received. On the other hand if what I'm sharing is coming merely from my soul, then I will not necessarily know if what I'm saying is being received or not.

I have sat in a church while only I and three other people were attending the service and two of the other three were sleeping while the minister was preaching what he no doubt considered an anointed message. He saw the condition of the ones who were in the pews but this obviously didn't distract him from his message. In my opinion this message did not come from spirit but soul, or ego.

This is not necessarily judging the occurrence but one of discerning. If I minister from my mind, there is no flowing of spirit. If that is where I minister from, then the best that I can do is build up people's ego. It's only when I minister from my deepest part, which is spirit that divine essence will flow to whoever is ready to receive what is flowing.

When a man has been dealt with through the crosses he has created from his lack of knowledge, when that breaking has done its work, it is then the life and essence of spirit will always be present when he shares his heart. When he shares, as he shares, he and the anointing become one. This is why he

always knows when what he is sharing is being received, and why when he senses it isn't will be forced to stop.

This is because of the nature of spirit. Its nature is such that it will never force or control any situation. In that sense it is meek. So again, in answer to your question, it is both. The one not receiving acts as a valve that shuts down the anointing that would otherwise flow. Once the resistance is known by the one sharing, and it always is, he feels drained and knows what is happening. Discernment and brokenness go together. You will never have one without the other.
